

Recycling Information

The metal which is used to fabricate Leland's gas filled cartridges is a low carbon steel which means it lends itself well to being melted down and used as recyclable content in another product.

To properly recycle, first make certain there is no gas remaining in the cartridge. A puncture hole through the small end of the cartridge means the gas has been evacuated as there is no valve in the cartridge.

Remove any labeling, if applicable, and place in a recycling collection container as you would with beverage or food cans.

Note: The cartridges are not designed to be refilled. It is against US Federal law to refill and transport our cartridges.
